What’s the Japan eVisa, Anyway?

The **Japan eVisa** is an online travel authorization that lets eligible travellers zip through the process without setting foot in a consulate. Documents You’ll Need

Don’t let a missing document be the plot twist you didn’t want. Gather these first:

- Valid Passport** (with at least 6 months left before it expires)
- Confirmed Flight Itinerary** (proof you’re going and coming back)
- Recent Bank Statement** (shows you can fund your stay)
- Residential Address** (where you’re currently living)
- Recent Passport-Sized Photo** (follow size rules so you’re not rejected)
- Proof of Residence/Visa** (if you’re applying from a place that’s not your home country)
- Accommodation Details** (hotel booking or your host’s address)
- Parental Consent Form** (for under-18 adventurers)



How to Apply (Step-by-Step)

- Fill Out the Online Application Form**
 - Head to the [Japan eVisa Application](#) portal and enter your details.
 - Upload the required documents (passport scans, flight info, photo, and more).
- Pay and Submit**
 - Use the secure payment system—credit card, debit card, or whichever method they accept.
 - Double-check your info so you don’t accidentally say you’re 200 years old (it happens!).
- Download Your eVisa**
 - Once approved, download and save your eVisa.
 - Print a copy or keep it handy on your phone—digital is the new black.



Common Reasons They Say “No”

- Incomplete or goofed-up application info.
- Invalid or expired passport.
- Insufficient financial proof.

- Poor-quality or mismatched passport photo.
- Missing or incorrect supporting docs.



Validity & Stay Period

- **Validity:** 90 days from when it’s issued.
- **Stay Duration:** You can hang out for up to 15 days.
- **Single Entry:** Each trip needs its own eVisa. Plan those return visits wisely!



Fees and Processing Speed

Processing Option	Timeframe	Extra Cost	Best For
Standard	26–32 work days	None	No rush, plan ahead
Rush	20–26 work days	Higher fee	Need it sooner
Super Rush	14–20 work days	Highest fee	Last-minute scramble
